

Windsor solar heads to Northwest Territories

Local solar company Green Sun Rising was awarded a large solar project in the Northwest Territories.

Green Sun Rising was selected to build an 81 kW solar photovoltaic system for a company called Northwest Territory Power Corp, in Colville Lake.

The solar system was designed and built in Windsor and will replace diesel power generation during sunny parts of the year for the utility company. A special ground-mounted system will allow the solar system to float on permafrost.

The solar system will be tied into a new power plant with a large battery system for energy storage.

This follows another project by Green Sun Rising in Northwest Territories, a 60 kW roof-top system installed in 2014.
